The company tent price includes a covered space, an uncovered "patio" area in front of the tent, plus lighting, one (1) eight foot rectangular table and a sign with your company name. You may order as many contiguous units of suites as necessary to accommodate your company's needs.

EVENT KEY DATES

Please make note of the important key dates for the 2026 event below:

Date	Description
Thursday, February 5	Company registration with post-race party reservations open.
Tuesday, February 24	Company registration with post-race party reservations close (unless capacity is reached earlier).
Tuesday, March 10	Race registration opens for company teams, unless capacity is reached during the post-race party registration. In that case, non-party companies may register for a wait list.
Thursday, March 12	Participant registration opens.
Tuesday, March 31	Catering orders open.
Tuesday, April 21	Catering orders close. All registration closes.

THE PARTY TERMS & CONDITIONS

GENERAL

Space for company tents is limited and will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. A waiting list of requests will be maintained, if necessary. **Payment for party spaces must be made by Friday, March 6, 2026. If payment for your party space is not received by March 6, your company team's order and entry will be removed from the event.** You will have the opportunity to register during general company registration if space is still available. Otherwise, you will be able to join the wait list.

Adjustments to your original orders may be requested until Tuesday, April 21, 2026, and will be accommodated to the extent possible. In the event that you must cancel your picnic area or tent suite order, your payment (less a cancellation fee of \$100.00) will be refunded only if we can replace your reservation with a company from the waiting list. After Tuesday, April 21, 2026, all orders are final and may not be transferred, canceled, or refunded even in the case of event cancellation. In the event of postponement or cancellation of the event due to elements beyond our control, neither JPMorganChase nor any of its subcontractors or vendors will be held liable for any loss incurred. We recommend that you contact your company insurer to learn if you are insured against such loss.

ALCOHOL

- A. Alcoholic beverages may be ordered only in company tents.
- B. All purchases of alcoholic beverages must be accompanied by a corresponding purchase of food items for the number of guests you will have in attendance. JPMorganChase reserves the right to review these quantities and communicate any required adjustments to the quantities of food or alcoholic beverage items ordered, in order to provide for a balance between each.
- C. Team Captains are responsible for ensuring that all guests in their company tent(s) are aged 21 or older. Alcoholic beverages will not be served to minors and the event caterer will require age identification of individuals suspected to be underage. Alcoholic beverage service will be denied to anyone showing any signs of inebriation or inappropriate behavior. Any such individuals may be identified to the Team Captain and the company may be denied race/company village entry for future Corporate Challenge races.
- D. Team Captains are required to submit the number of guests expected at their company tent(s) for whom they are purchasing food and alcoholic beverages. A minimum of one (1) dedicated

attendant per up to 50 guests is required for all alcoholic purchases at a cost of \$581 per dedicated attendant (tax is included). An additional dedicated attendant for incremental quantities of up to 50 people will be required at a cost of \$581 per dedicated attendant (tax is included).

E. Professional dedicated attendant(s) will receive, secure, and control the distribution of the beer and wine within each company tent(s). Wine will be poured only by the bartenders and only into plastic cups. No wine bottles will be distributed. Beer will be served only in cans.

F. The dedicated attendant(s) will serve alcoholic beverages only to those who present an alcoholic beverage wristband coupon. Companies will be limited to two (2) alcoholic beverage coupons per person. Alcoholic beverage coupon wristbands will be distributed only to Team Captains as they arrive at the event site on the day of their event.

G. Tipping of dedicated attendant(s) is prohibited.

H. Last call for alcoholic beverages is 9:30 p.m. The company village closes at 10:00 p.m.

I. All leftover and unused or partially used wine bottles and/or beer cans must remain in the tent for collection by catering staff at the end of the event. There will be no refunds for unused wine or beer.

J. Adjustments to original orders may be requested until Tuesday, April 21, 2026 and will be accommodated to the extent possible. Alcoholic beverages will not be available for purchase during the events.

K. No company or participant will be permitted to bring their own alcoholic beverage(s) into the company village, either as an alternative to, or in addition to, the alcoholic beverage pre-purchase and serving plan.

L. Alcoholic beverage consumption will be limited to the defined space within each company tent (tented and patio area).
